Abuse and addiction

The task of the alcohol and narcotics group is to give residents of Piteå the opportunity to change their drinking and drug habits. You can also turn to us if you are living in a close relationship with an addict. You have the right to remain anonymous.

We determine together what type of support you need and can benefit from. We offer individually tailored treatments, such as:

- solution-focused brief therapy
- individual or group relapse prevention
- possibility to document sobriety
- dosing of Antabuse that you have been prescribed by a doctor
- support in your contact with other social services and authorities
- support for family and friends

Once you have decided which measure or measures you want to employ, we will create a treatment plan and, in most cases, you can start treatment right away.

If you want to make an application to stay in a treatment centre, you will be put in contact with one of our social workers on staff. The social worker will provide you with information about processing, investigation and decisions.

Those of us working here have a duty of confidentiality and will not share information with your employer, family members, etc. If you want, you can choose a person close to you or an official to receive information about your recovery.

We will be exempt from the duty of confidentiality if we discover that a child is being mistreated or if we are required by law or constitution to provide information.

You can pay us a visit free of charge.
