II. Contents of the meeting:

1. Opening the meeting by Brith Fäldt

Welcome An Giang delegation to Piteå and informed to start the meeting

2. Information about ICLD by Karin Norlin Bogren

Mrs. Karin Norlin Bogren brieftly itntroduced about herself and ICLD as well as four core areas which aims to sustainable development.

She pressed that steering group plays an important role in supporting the commitment to implement project activities. Member of steering group will decide to apply those results in a sustainable way. She shared that ICLD focuses on 3 activities: Municipal Partnership programme, Training programmes and knowledge center.

She had positive comments about the project. She also emphasized that the cooperation program between An Giang and Piteå is one of the most successful programs she has ever approved.

3. Minutes from the last meeting in March

Approved contents of the minutes of Monitoring committee meeting in An Giang in March 2019.

4. Update on today's situation in An Giang province concerning growth from 2011 in different sectors like income, social welfare, etc.: Mrs. Phạm Ngọc Xuân

Mrs. Pham Ngọc Xuân had a short report on average growth rates in periods: 2012-1015; 2016-2018 of An Giang province.

Mr. Ho Viet Hiep supported on explaining why GDP decreased. He suggested that we can overcome by trying to develop the depth of the products. It is necessary to exploit the value chain of rice as well as fish value chain such as pine. To do that we need technical and technology support to develop.

Representing An Giang, he thanked Piteå for accompanying the development of An Giang during years. In upcoming congress, An Giang will put above issues into development-oriented.

* Comments:

Regarding impact of the project on socio-economy from 2012:

Mr. Bo Wiberg reminded that from waste is rice husk and straw now has brought profits to the people. Even so we are trying to continue turning rice by-products into energy and valuable products. We can also learn from other countries (China). We have demonstration models in the project. Importantly, the project has done very well with communication with farmers. We also explained to the people about price volatility but we believe that one day, people will take advantage and increase income from the rice value chain.

In the process of implementing the demonstration models, we need to choose some good farmers as the focal points to contact and support other households.

Mr. Göran Dahlén had a question about expanding demonstration models and what farmers have been supported.

Mrs. Đinh Thị Việt Huỳnh confirmed that there are difficulties in calling investment in turning rice husk into energy. However, Ministry of Science and Technology is willing to support. The main issue is lack of investors.

5. Progress report from the project: Mr. Bo Wiberg

Got through results of the project in 2018. Almost activities were implemented but online meeting between young students from both sides. To carry out this activity, Piteå's side need more time for preparation and discussion with their students

Activity in 2019:

An Giang and Sweden Project Management Unit in An Giang province will list what activities need budget support and send to Mr. Bo Wiberg.

MC members from An Giang side suggested having first MC meeting in Piteå next year (March).
