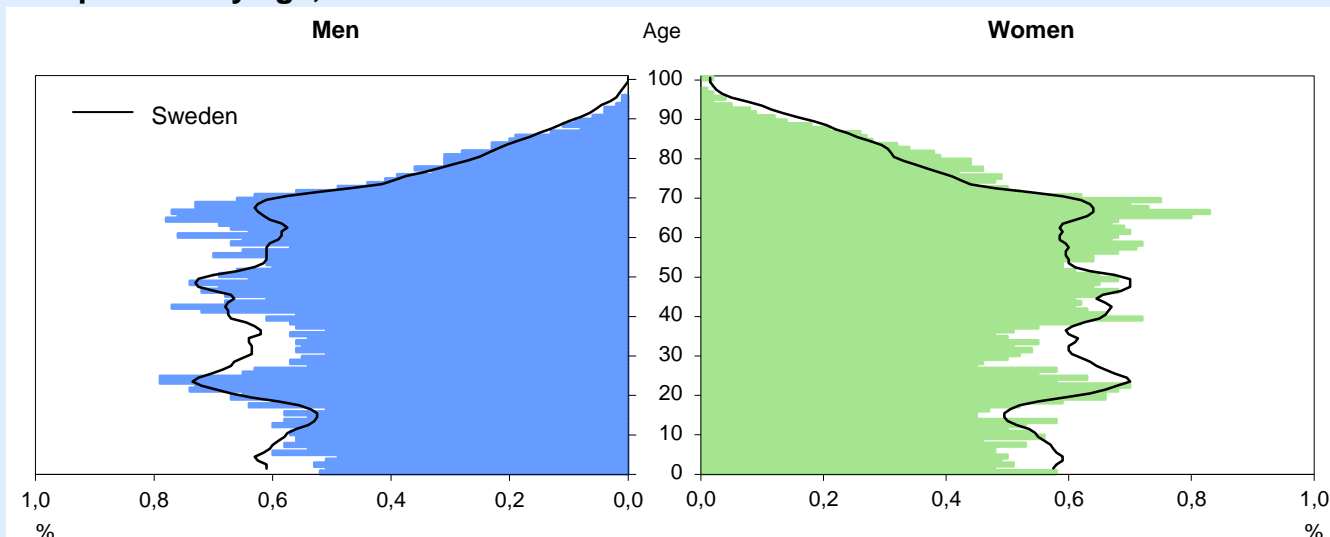

Population by age, 2013



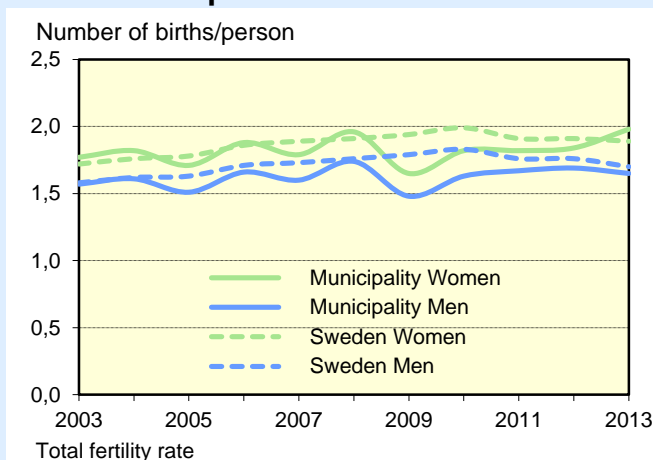

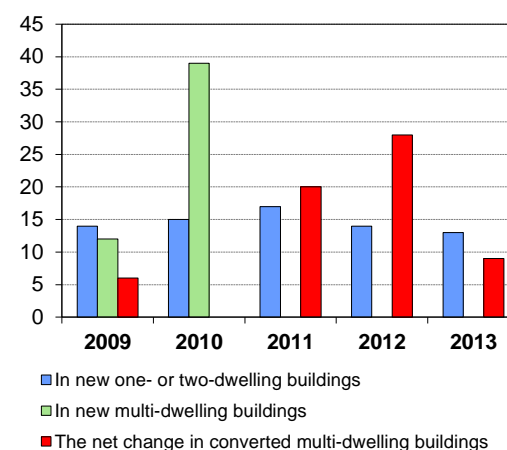

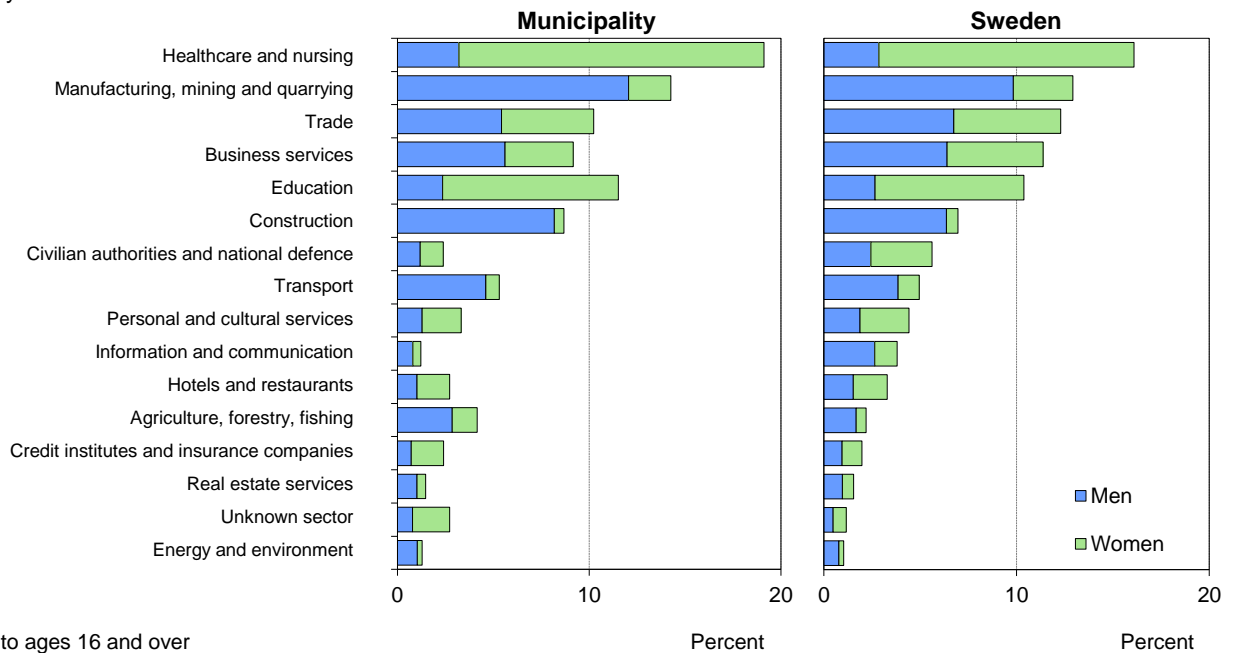

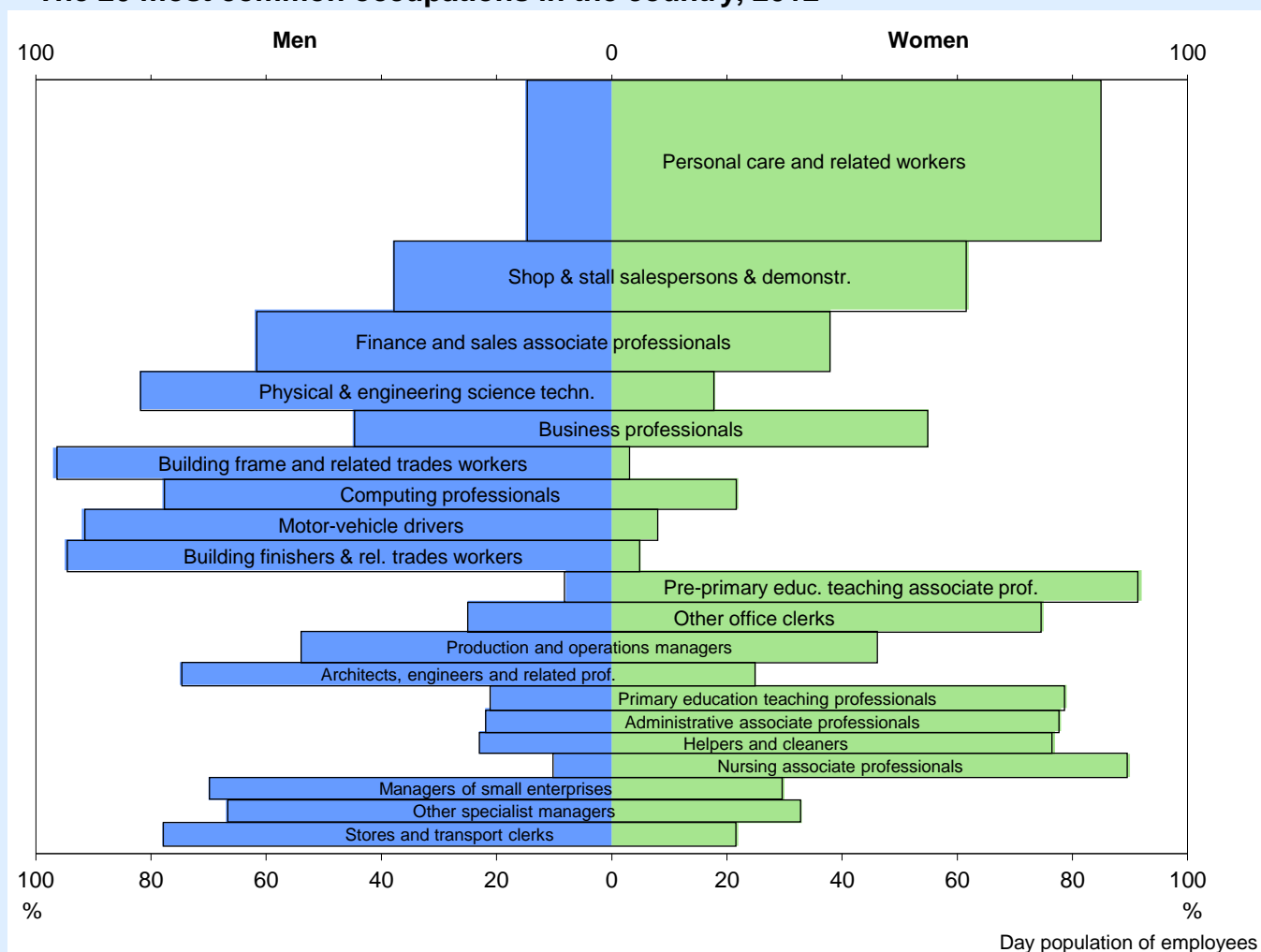

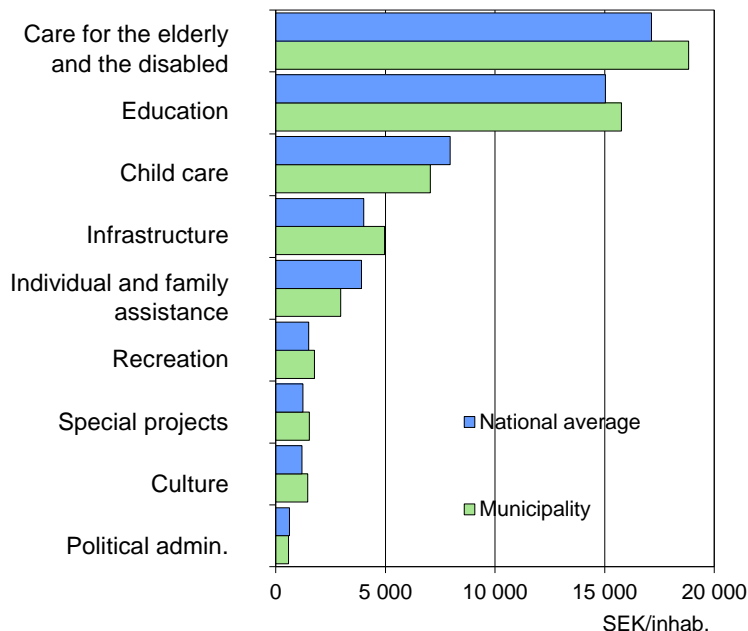
